OFFICIAL POLICY - Use of Private Call

DATE: December 4, 2000

PURPOSE: Supervisors needing to contact key personnel to minimize unnecessary monitoring of sensitive issues by internal and external personnel.

SCOPE: Should be authorized to certain key supervisory and above personnel. Private call will be limited to these key staff: key managers, key supervisors, Battalion Chiefs, and above, and captains and above.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Private Call is a capability which can be programmed into Motorola Model III radios, from which, by using the keypad, the radio can be used to establish a private call with another radio.

Private call will use one or two channels, depending on location, during duration of the call. As Private Call affects system resources, it should be kept at a minimum and only used when operational needs dictate.
