Resolution 2009 – 3

A Resolution to Cooperate in the Statewide DTRS with the CCNC

Be it resolved by the Pikes Peak Regional Communications Network Board:

Section 1.

The Pikes Peak Regional Communications Network Board finds that cooperating in the Colorado Statewide Digital Trunked Radio System will provide a more robust public safety radio interoperability environment than operating the PPRCN network independently from the Statewide DTRS, which independence has been the case to date.

The Pikes Peak Regional Communications Network Board believes that cooperation with other participants in the Consolidated Communications Network of Colorado will be mutually beneficial going forward, and anticipates that it will remain beneficial indefinitely.

The Pikes Peak Regional Communications Network Board asserts that although cooperation within the Statewide DTRS will allow mutual resource sharing, that the ownership, financing, control and operation of the PPRCN network will remain in the hands of the PPRCN Members, who are the City of Colorado Springs and the County of El Paso. The PPRCN Board further asserts that decisions to remain affiliated within the Statewide DTRS are not intractable.


Section 2.
